## A SUPPLEMENT

- To the act of March 1, 1988 (P.L.82, No.16), entitled "An act providing for the establishment, implementation and 1 2 administration of the Pennsylvania Infrastructure Investment 3 Authority; imposing powers and duties on a board of trustees; 5 transferring the rights, powers, duties and obligations of the Water Facilities Loan Board to the Pennsylvania 6 Infrastructure Investment Authority; providing for the 7 issuance of notes and bonds; providing for financial 8 assistance and for a comprehensive water facilities plan; 9 authorizing a referendum to incur indebtedness; making an 10 appropriation; and making repeals," providing for additional projects to mitigate contamination of sources of drinking 11 12 water. 13
- 14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 15 hereby enacts as follows:
- 16 Section 1. Short title.
- 17 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Drinking
- 18 Water Contamination Mitigation Act.
- Section 2. Intent. 19
- 20 The intent of this act is to supplement efforts by the
- 21 Federal Government, the Commonwealth and municipalities to
- 22 provide equipment necessary to mitigate contamination of sources
- 23 of drinking water contaminated in connection with the former

- 1 Naval Air Station Joint Reserve Base Willow Grove, now known as
- 2 the Horsham Air Guard Station, but impacting the ground water
- 3 and aquifer in the area.
- 4 Section 3. Definitions.
- 5 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 6 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 7 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 8 "Authority." The Pennsylvania Infrastructure Investment
- 9 Authority.
- 10 Section 4. Eligibility.
- 11 For the 2016-2017 fiscal year, funds of the authority may be
- 12 used to fund grants for projects that install updated
- 13 infrastructure to ensure clean drinking water in a township of
- 14 the second class with a population between 21,500 and 24,500
- 15 based on the most recent Federal decennial census that is also
- 16 located in a county of the second class A and in a township of
- 17 the second class with a population between 32,600 and 34,000
- 18 based on the most recent Federal decennial census that is also
- 19 located in a county of the second class A.
- 20 Section 5. Reimbursement.
- 21 Nothing in this act or any other law shall be construed to
- 22 prohibit the authority from being reimbursed by the Federal
- 23 Government for funds expended by the authority associated with
- 24 the installation of infrastructure to ensure clean drinking
- 25 water.
- 26 Section 6. Construction.
- 27 This act shall be read in pari materia with the act of March
- 28 1, 1988 (P.L.82, No.16), known as the Pennsylvania
- 29 Infrastructure Investment Authority Act.
- 30 Section 7. Effective date.

1 This act shall take effect immediately.
