AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of August 24, 1963 (P.L.1175, No.497), entitled
- "An act to codify, amend, revise and consolidate the laws
- relating to mechanics' liens," further providing for
- 4 definitions.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 201(5) of the act of August 24, 1963
- 8 (P.L.1175, No.497), known as the Mechanics' Lien Law of 1963,
- 9 amended June 29, 2006 (P.L.210, No.52), is amended to read:
- 10 Section 201. Definitions. -- The following words, terms and
- 11 phrases when used in this act shall have the meaning ascribed to
- 12 them in this section, except where the context clearly indicates
- 13 a different meaning:
- 14 * * *
- 15 (5) "Subcontractor" means one who, by contract with the
- 16 contractor, or pursuant to a contract with a subcontractor in
- 17 direct privity of a contract with a contractor, express or
- 18 implied, erects, constructs, alters or repairs an improvement or

- 1 any part thereof; or furnishes labor, skill or superintendence
- 2 thereto; or supplies or hauls materials, fixtures, machinery or
- 3 equipment reasonably necessary for and actually used therein; or
- 4 <u>is a fund governed or regulated by the Employee Retirement</u>
- 5 Income Security Act of 1974 (Public Law 93-406, 88 Stat. 829)
- 6 for the benefit of persons furnishing labor or materials to an
- 7 <u>improvement;</u> or any or all of the foregoing, whether as
- 8 superintendent, builder or materialman. The term does not
- 9 include an architect or engineer who contracts with a contractor
- 10 or subcontractor, or a person who contracts with a materialman
- 11 or a person who contracts with a subcontractor not in direct
- 12 privity of a contract with a contractor.

- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
