- 2 § 901. Scope.
- 3 This chapter relates to the Commonwealth Economic Development
- 4 Action Team.
- 5 § 902. Definitions.
- 6 The following words and phrases when used in this chapter
- 7 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 8 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 9 <u>"Committee." The Commonwealth Economic Development Selection</u>
- 10 and Organization Committee established under section 907(a)
- 11 <u>(relating to Commonwealth Economic Development Selection and</u>
- 12 Organization Committee).
- "Executive agency." A department, board or commission of the
- 14 Executive Department which is under the policy supervision and
- 15 control of the Governor.
- 16 "Executive director." The executive director of the team
- 17 appointed under section 903(b) (relating to Commonwealth
- 18 Economic Development Action Team).
- 19 "Project." An effort by a qualified business which will
- 20 result in any of the following:
- 21 (1) A meaningful increase in the number of jobs in this
- 22 <u>Commonwealth.</u>
- 23 (2) A substantial increase in the amount of tax revenue
- 24 <u>collected by the Commonwealth.</u>
- 25 "Oualified business." A business that is authorized to do
- 26 business in this Commonwealth and has received an evaluation
- 27 <u>under section 904(c) (relating to powers and duties of team).</u>
- 28 "Team." The Commonwealth Economic Development Action Team
- 29 established under section 903(a).
- 30 "Team member." An employee of the department who has been

- 1 appointed as staff of the team under section 903(c).
- 2 § 903. Commonwealth Economic Development Action Team.
- 3 (a) Establishment.--The Commonwealth Economic Development
- 4 Action Team is established as an office within the department.
- 5 (b) Executive director. -- The team shall be directed by an
- 6 executive director. Within 90 days of the effective date of this
- 7 <u>section</u>, the committee shall appoint an executive director to
- 8 direct the team. The Executive Board established under section
- 9 <u>204 of the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The</u>
- 10 Administrative Code of 1929, shall set the compensation of the
- 11 executive director.
- 12 (c) Staffing. -- The executive director shall appoint
- 13 <u>individuals</u>, including experienced economic development
- 14 professionals, to act as staff of the team as may be
- 15 appropriate. The executive director may contract for additional
- 16 <u>services as necessary for the performance of the executive</u>
- 17 director's duties.
- 18 (d) Legal services. -- The Office of General Counsel shall
- 19 provide legal services as necessary to the team.
- 20 (e) Administrative services.--
- 21 (1) The department shall provide administrative services
- and staff to the team. The team shall reimburse the
- 23 <u>department for the cost of providing the administrative</u>
- services and staff under this paragraph.
- 25 (2) The executive director may enter into an agreement
- 26 with the department setting forth the rights and obligations
- 27 <u>of the team and the department in carrying out their duties</u>
- to each other under this chapter and to further the intent of
- 29 this chapter.
- 30 (f) Appropriation. -- The appropriation for the team shall be

- 1 in a separate line item and shall be under the jurisdiction of
- 2 the executive director.
- 3 § 904. Powers and duties of team.
- 4 (a) Single point of contact. -- The team shall serve as a
- 5 single point of contact for a business considering moving to,
- 6 considering expanding in or seeking to maintain operations in
- 7 this Commonwealth.
- 8 (b) Regional offices. -- The executive director shall
- 9 establish appropriate regions and regional offices for the team
- 10 across this Commonwealth.
- 11 (c) Evaluation. -- Upon the request of a business, the team
- 12 shall evaluate the needs of the business and a proposed project,
- 13 <u>including all of the following:</u>
- 14 (1) The overall economic impact of the proposed project.
- 15 (2) The financial condition of the business.
- 16 (3) The strength of the business model of the business.
- 17 (4) The strength of the commitments for private
- 18 <u>financing for the proposed project.</u>
- 19 (5) The competitive posture of the proposed project.
- 20 (d) Assignment of team members. -- The team shall assign a
- 21 team member for a qualified business, who shall serve as the
- 22 primary point of contact for the qualified business and the
- 23 team.
- 24 (e) Referrals for assistance. -- Upon completing a review
- 25 under subsection (c), the team may refer a qualified business
- 26 for assistance under section 905 (relating to assistance for
- 27 <u>qualified businesses</u>) and other economic development programs.
- 28 (f) Survey and feedback. -- The team shall annually survey
- 29 <u>qualified businesses and provide an opportunity to submit</u>
- 30 feedback on the assistance provided under this chapter. The team

- 1 shall provide the survey results and feedback under this
- 2 subsection to the committee.
- 3 (g) Performance metrics. -- The team shall collect and compile
- 4 performance metrics relating to the actions of the team,
- 5 <u>including the data necessary to compile the annual report under</u>
- 6 <u>section 908 (relating to annual report).</u>
- 7 § 905. Assistance for qualified businesses.
- 8 (a) Site selection. -- The team shall do all of the following:
- 9 <u>(1) Maintain a site selection database on a publicly</u>
- 10 <u>accessible Internet website</u>, which shall include a voluntary
- 11 <u>registration of business site locations and information on</u>
- 12 <u>available resources.</u>
- 13 (2) Provide individualized site selection assistance for
- 14 <u>a qualified business.</u>
- 15 (b) Interagency coordination. -- The team shall do all of the
- 16 following:
- 17 (1) Coordinate the involvement of executive agencies in
- 18 a project.
- 19 (2) Facilitate introductions with relevant executive
- 20 agencies.
- 21 (3) To the extent permitted by law and policy of an
- 22 executive agency, facilitate the permit review and approval
- for a project.
- 24 (c) Economic development. -- The team shall do all of the
- 25 following:
- 26 (1) Refer a qualified business to economic development
- 27 <u>programs and other grant programs that are available to the</u>
- 28 qualified business.
- 29 (2) At the request of a qualified business, consult with
- 30 an executive agency about applications by the qualified

- 1 business for a program or permit administered by the
- 2 executive agency.
- 3 § 906. Duties of executive agencies.
- 4 (a) Consultation with team members. -- Except as otherwise
- 5 provided by Federal law or an applicable duty or privilege, an
- 6 <u>executive agency shall agree to consult with a team member for</u>
- 7 the purpose of section 905(c)(2) (relating to assistance for
- 8 <u>qualified businesses</u>). The executive agency may require a
- 9 <u>qualified business to request the consultation under this</u>
- 10 subsection in writing.
- 11 <u>(b) (Reserved).</u>
- 12 § 907. Commonwealth Economic Development Selection and
- 13 <u>Organization Committee.</u>
- 14 (a) Establishment.--The Commonwealth Economic Development
- 15 <u>Selection and Organization Committee is established as a</u>
- 16 committee within the team.
- 17 (b) Duties.--The committee shall establish all of the
- 18 <u>following:</u>
- 19 (1) Procedures to select the executive director.
- 20 (2) The operational budget of the team.
- 21 (c) Composition. -- The committee shall be comprised of the
- 22 <u>following members:</u>
- 23 (1) The Governor or a designee.
- 24 (2) The President pro tempore of the Senate or a
- designee.
- 26 (3) The Majority Leader of the Senate or a designee.
- 27 (4) The Minority Leader of the Senate or a designee.
- 28 (5) The Speaker of the House of Representatives or a
- designee.
- 30 (6) The Majority Leader of the House of Representatives

- 1 or a designee.
- 2 (7) The Minority Leader of the House of Representatives
- 3 or a designee.
- 4 (d) Operations.--
- 5 (1) The committee shall conduct a meeting to organize
- 6 within 30 days of the effective date of this section.
- 7 (2) The members of the committee shall select a member
- 8 of the committee to serve as chair. The chair shall call
- 9 <u>meetings of the committee.</u>
- 10 (3) The committee shall act upon a vote of the majority
- of the members of the committee.
- 12 § 908. Annual report.
- 13 (a) Report. -- No later than March 31, 2023, and each March 31
- 14 thereafter, the executive director shall publish an annual
- 15 report on the team.
- 16 (b) Contents. --- The annual report under subsection (a) shall
- 17 include all of the following information:
- 18 (1) The number of businesses that used the team as a
- 19 single point of contact under section 904(a) (relating to
- 20 powers and duties of team) during the prior calendar year.
- 21 (2) The number of businesses that were evaluated under
- 22 section 904(c) during the prior calendar year.
- 23 (3) The number of qualified businesses which received
- 24 assistance from the team during the prior calendar year.
- 25 (4) To the extent possible, all of the following
- 26 information:
- (i) The number of jobs retained in this Commonwealth
- for projects which received assistance from the team.
- 29 (ii) The number of jobs added in this Commonwealth
- 30 for projects which received assistance from the team.

- 1 (iii) The amount of additional capital investment in
- 2 this Commonwealth for projects which received assistance
- 3 from the team.
- 4 Section 2. The Governor's Action Team is abolished. All
- 5 personnel, allocations, appropriations, equipment, files,
- 6 records, contracts, agreements, obligations and other materials
- 7 which are used, employed or expended in connection with the
- 8 functions of the Governor's Action Team are hereby transferred
- 9 to the Commonwealth Economic Development Action Team, with the
- 10 same force and effect as if:
- 11 (1) The allocations and appropriations had been made to
- 12 the Commonwealth Economic Development Action Team in the
- 13 first instance.
- 14 (2) The personnel, equipment, files, records and other
- 15 materials of the Governor's Action Team had been the
- 16 personnel and property of the Commonwealth Economic
- 17 Development Action Team in the first instance.
- 18 (3) The contracts, agreements and obligations of the
- 19 Governor's Action Team had been incurred or entered into by
- 20 the Commonwealth Economic Development Action Team.
- 21 Section 3. Except as otherwise provided under 12 Pa.C.S. Ch.
- 22 9, all activities initiated by the Governor's Action Team prior
- 23 to the effective date of this section shall continue and remain
- 24 in full force and effect and may be completed by the
- 25 Commonwealth Economic Development Action Team. Orders,
- 26 regulations, rules and decisions which were made prior to the
- 27 effective date of this section and which are in effect on the
- 28 effective date of this section shall remain in full force and
- 29 effect until revoked, vacated or modified by the Commonwealth
- 30 Economic Development Action Team. Contracts, obligations and

- 1 collective bargaining agreements entered into by the Governor's
- 2 Action Team are not affected nor impaired by this act.
- 3 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
