11	(C) REFUNDABLE REGISTRATION FEETHE FOLLOWING SHALL APPLY: <
12	(1) NO FEE SHALL BE CHARGED TO an individual who
13	registers for an approved motorcycle safety course except for
14	a nominal registration fee as determined by the department
15	which shall not exceed \$50 and shall be refunded if the
16	individual attends the approved motorcycle safety course. Any
17	nominal registration fee not refunded under this subsection
18	shall be deposited into the Motorcycle Safety Education

3	(2) WITHIN 18 MONTHS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS <
4	SUBSECTION, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ISSUE A REPORT ANALYZING THE
5	EFFECT OF THE FEE AUTHORIZED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION ON
6	ENROLLMENT IN MOTORCYCLE SAFETY COURSES. THE REPORT SHALL BE
7	ISSUED TO THE CHAIRPERSON AND MINORITY CHAIRPERSON OF THE
8	TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE OF THE SENATE AND THE CHAIRPERSON
9	AND MINORITY CHAIRPERSON OF THE TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE OF
10	THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND POSTED ON THE DEPARTMENT'S
11	PUBLICLY ACCESSIBLE INTERNET WEBSITE. THE REPORT SHALL
12	INCLUDE ALL OF THE FOLLOWING:
13	(I) DATA REGARDING THE NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS WHO
14	COMPLETED A MOTORCYCLE SAFETY COURSE PRIOR TO THE
15	EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SUBSECTION.
16	(II) DATA REGARDING THE NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS WHO
17	ENROLLED IN A MOTORCYCLE SAFETY COURSE PRIOR TO THE
18	EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SUBSECTION AND FAILED TO ATTEND
19	THE MOTORCYCLE SAFETY COURSE.
20	(III) DATA REGARDING THE NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS WHO
21	COMPLETED A MOTORCYCLE SAFETY COURSE AFTER THE EFFECTIVE
22	DATE OF THIS SUBSECTION.
23	(IV) DATA REGARDING THE NUMBER OF INDIVIDUALS WHO
24	ENROLLED IN A MOTORCYCLE SAFETY COURSE AFTER THE
25	EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS SUBSECTION AND FAILED TO ATTEND
26	THE MOTORCYCLE SAFETY COURSE.
27	(V) THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF FEES REFUNDED UNDER THIS
28	SUBSECTION.
29	(VI) THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF FEES DEPOSITED INTO THE
30	MOTORCYCLE SAFETY EDUCATION ACCOUNT UNDER THIS

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1	SUBSECTION.
2	(VII) SUGGESTED STATUTORY CHANGES THAT MAY IMPROVE
3	ENROLLMENT IN MOTORCYCLE SAFETY COURSES.
4	(VIII) ANY OTHER INFORMATION AT THE DISCRETION OF
5	THE DEPARTMENT.
6	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
