1 2 3 4	Amending Title 35 (Health and Safety) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in Commonwealth services, providing for retail store closure during declaration of disaster emergency.
5	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6	hereby enacts as follows:
7	Section 1. Title 35 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8	Statutes is amended by adding a section to read:
9	<u>§ 7309. Retail store closure during declaration of disaster</u>
10	emergency.
11	Notwithstanding the provisions of this chapter or any other
12	provision of law to the contrary, the Governor may not close a
13	retail store during a declaration of disaster emergency under
14	section 7301 (relating to general authority of Governor) if the
15	<u>retail store:</u>
16	(1) restricts access during a declaration of disaster
17	emergency to one customer in the retail store facility at a
18	time; and

1 (2) restricts store operations to one employee in the

2 <u>retail store facility at a time.</u>

3 Section 2. All regulations and parts of regulations are 4 abrogated to the extent of any inconsistency with the provisions 5 of this act.

6 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
