AN ACT

Amending Title 63 (Professions and Occupations (State Licensed)) 1 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in powers and 2 duties, providing for temporary rulemaking authority. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Title 63 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a section to read: 7 § 3119. Temporary rulemaking authority. 8 9 (a) Promulgation. -- A licensing board or licensing commission 10 under the bureau that is subject to an interstate licensure compact act may promulgate ONE-TIME temporary regulations 11 necessary for the implementation of licensure compacts EACH 12 <--13 LICENSURE COMPACT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY. The temporary 14 regulations shall not be subject to: 15 (1) Sections 201, 202, 203 and 205 of the act of July 31, 1968 (P.L.769, No.240), referred to as the Commonwealth 16

- 2 (P.L.950, No.164), known as the Commonwealth Attorneys Act.

- 5 <u>(b) Expiration. -- Temporary regulations promulgated under </u> <--
- 6 this section shall expire no later than three years following
- 7 the publication of the temporary regulations in the Pennsylvania
- 8 <u>Bulletin. Regulations adopted after expiration of temporary</u>
- 9 <u>regulations promulgated under this section shall be promulgated</u>
- 10 as provided by law.
- 11 (B) EXPIRATION OF AUTHORITY TO PROMULGATE. -- THE AUTHORITY OF <--
- 12 A LICENSING BOARD OR LICENSING COMMISSION TO PROMULGATE ONE-TIME
- 13 TEMPORARY REGULATIONS UNDER THIS SECTION FOR EACH LICENSURE
- 14 COMPACT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY SHALL EXPIRE ON THE DATE
- 15 OF PUBLICATION OF THE TEMPORARY REGULATIONS IN THE PENNSYLVANIA
- 16 BULLETIN.
- 17 (C) EXPIRATION OF TEMPORARY REGULATIONS.--TEMPORARY
- 18 REGULATIONS PROMULGATED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL EXPIRE NO LATER
- 19 THAN THREE YEARS FOLLOWING THE PUBLICATION OF THE TEMPORARY
- 20 REGULATIONS IN THE PENNSYLVANIA BULLETIN. REGULATIONS ADOPTED
- 21 AFTER EXPIRATION OF TEMPORARY REGULATIONS PROMULGATED UNDER THIS
- 22 SECTION SHALL BE PROMULGATED AS PROVIDED BY LAW.
- 23 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
