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AN ACT

1 Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated  
2 Statutes, in size, weight and load, further providing for  
3 limits on number of towed vehicles, for length of vehicles  
4 and for application to tow trucks.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 4904(c)(2) of Title 75 of the  
8 Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:

9 § 4904. Limits on number of towed vehicles.

11 (c) Towing vehicles requiring service.--

13 (2) A combination, including a truck tractor with no  
14 more than two trailers, requiring emergency service may be  
15 towed to a [nearby garage or other place of safety.] place of  
16 repairs of the owner's choosing or other place of safety off  
17 of a highway as provided in sections 4923 (relating to length  
18 of vehicles) and 4949 (relating to application to tow  
19 trucks).

2 Section 2. Section 4923(b.1) of Title 75 is amended by  
3 adding a paragraph to read:

4 § 4923. Length of vehicles.

6 (b.1) Combinations.--

7 \* \* \*

8 (10) This subsection shall not apply to a tow truck  
9 towing a truck tractor with no more than two trailers  
10 requiring emergency service as provided in section 4904(c)(2)  
11 (relating to limits on number of towed vehicles).

13 Section 3. Section 4949 of Title 75 is amended to read:

14 § 4949. Application to tow trucks.

15 The weight restrictions set forth in this subchapter do not  
16 apply to a combination consisting of any tow truck towing a  
17 disabled motor vehicle or truck tractor with no more than two  
18 trailers to a place of repairs or other place of safety as long  
19 as the overweight combination travels directly to the [first  
20 available such location and the movement is performed at the  
21 direction of authorized emergency personnel or a qualified  
22 Commonwealth employee] place of repairs or place of safety.

23 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
