16	(d.1) Destruction of mediaA person convicted of an
17	offense under this section shall delete or destroy any
18	photograph, videotape, electronic depiction, film, record or any
19	other recording associated with the conviction that is in the

- 1 person's possession in any manner or form. Failure to delete or
- 2 <u>destroy the media shall constitute a separate offense graded as</u>
- 3 <u>a felony of the third degree.</u>
