## AN ACT

- Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in falsification and intimidation
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, in falsification and intimidation, 3 further providing for false reports to law enforcement
- 4 authorities.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 4906 of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania
- 8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:
- 9 § 4906. False reports to law enforcement authorities.

- 11 (d) Restitution. -- A person convicted of violating subsection
- 12 (a) or (b) shall, in addition to any other sentence imposed or
- 13 restitution ordered under 42 Pa.C.S. § 9721(c) (relating to
- 14 <u>sentencing generally</u>), be sentenced to pay restitution in an
- 15 amount equal to the costs incurred for any fire or police
- 16 <u>response</u>, <u>emergency medical service or emergency preparedness</u>
- 17 response or governmental agency response to the false
- 18 <u>information or report.</u>

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
