AN ACT

1 Amending Titles 51 (Military Affairs) and 61 (Prisons and
2 Parole) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in
3 Department of Military Affairs, further providing for duties
4 of department; in State Veterans' Commission and Deputy
5 Adjutant General for Veterans' Affairs, further providing for
6 specific duties relating to Deputy Adjutant General for
7 Veterans' Affairs; and, in general administration relating to
8 correctional institutions, further providing for powers and
9 duties of department.

10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
11 hereby enacts as follows:

12 Section 1. Section 702 of Title 51 of the Pennsylvania
13 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a paragraph to read:

14 § 702. Duties of department.

15 The department shall have the power and its duty shall be:

16 * * *

17 (13) To contact veterans whose names appear on the list
18 transmitted to the department under 61 Pa.C.S. § 1105(a)(3)
19 (relating to powers and duties of department) and encourage
20 their voter registration.

1 Section 2. Section 1712(6) and (7) of Title 51 are amended
2 and the section is amended by adding a paragraph to read:

3 § 1712. Specific duties.

4 In addition to such other duties as may be provided by law or
5 as assigned by the Adjutant General, the Deputy Adjutant General
6 for Veterans' Affairs shall have the following specific duties:

7 * * *

8 (6) To aid in the rehabilitation of injured, wounded or
9 compensable veterans in educational institutions or
10 [vocational training] career and technical training
11 institutions for which they may be eligible by law.

12 (7) To cooperate with and advise the Department of
13 Education with respect to [vocational] career and technical
14 training programs for veterans, particularly programs suited
15 to casualties.

16 * * *

17 (17) To encourage voter registration among veterans.

18 Section 3. Section 1105(a) of Title 61 is amended by adding
19 a paragraph and the section is amended by adding a subsection to
20 read:

21 § 1105. Powers and duties of department.

22 (a) General rule.--The department shall have the power and
23 its duty shall be:

24 * * *

25 (3) To maintain a list of individuals who are both
26 veterans and committed to a term of imprisonment or otherwise
27 confined under the custody of the Commonwealth and to
28 transmit their names and addresses, not less than 30 days
29 prior to their release or discharge from confinement, to the
30 Department of Military and Veterans Affairs.

2 (c) Definition.--As used in this section, the term "veteran"
3 means the same as in 51 Pa.C.S. § 7101.2 (relating to
4 definitions).

5 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
