AN ACT

- Amending the act of December 5, 1936 (2nd Sp.Sess., 1937 P.L.2897, No.1), entitled "An act establishing a system of 1 2 unemployment compensation to be administered by the 3 Department of Labor and Industry and its existing and newly 5 created agencies with personnel (with certain exceptions) selected on a civil service basis; requiring employers to keep records and make reports, and certain employers to pay 6 contributions based on payrolls to provide moneys for the 8 payment of compensation to certain unemployed persons; 9 providing procedure and administrative details for the 10 determination, payment and collection of such contributions 11 and the payment of such compensation; providing for 12 cooperation with the Federal Government and its agencies; 13 creating certain special funds in the custody of the State 14 Treasurer; and prescribing penalties," in administration of 15 act, providing for reasonable accommodations. 16 17 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 18 hereby enacts as follows: 19 Section 1. The act of December 5, 1936 (2nd Sp.Sess., 1937) 20 P.L.2897, No.1), known as the Unemployment Compensation Law, is 21 amended by adding a section to read: 22 Section 212.1. Reasonable Accommodations. -- The department 23 shall make reasonable accommodations upon request for all
- 24 claimants with a disability who are eligible for compensation

- 1 and referred to employment offices for reemployment services.
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
