21	(1) During a public health emergency declared as a

23	facility or personal care home shall quarantine the employees

- 8 (b) Monitor.--During a public health emergency declared as a
- 9 <u>result of a communicable disease</u>, a long-term care nursing
- 10 facility or personal care home shall monitor the employees and
- 11 residents of the long-term care nursing facility or personal
- 12 care home for the duration of the known incubation period of the
- 13 communicable disease.
- 14 (c) Duties of department. -- During a public health emergency
- 15 <u>declared as a result of a communicable disease, the department</u>
- 16 shall have the following duties:
- 17 (1) Conduct a review of a health care facility that has
- an increased rate of infection of the communicable disease
- 19 from the community.
- 20 (2) Implement guidelines to protect the employees and
- 21 residents of a health care facility specified under paragraph
- 22 (1) to prevent an increase in community spread of the
- 23 <u>communicable disease.</u>
- 24 (d) Employment services. -- An employee subject to quarantine
- 25 under subsection (a) may continue to provide employment services
- 26 for the long-term care nursing facility or personal care home if
- 27 the employee has no symptoms of the communicable disease. A
- 28 long-term care nursing facility or personal care home may not
- 29 require an employee subject to quarantine under subsection (a)
- 30 to provide employment services for the long-term care nursing

- 1 <u>facility or personal care home as a condition of receiving food</u>,
- 2 water, shelter or other necessities of living.
- 3 (e) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 4 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 5 subsection:
- 6 <u>"Communicable disease."</u> As defined in section 2(c) of the
- 7 <u>act of April 23, 1956 (1955 P.L.1510, No.500), known as the</u>
- 8 Disease Prevention and Control Law of 1955.
- 9 "Personal care home." As defined in section 1001 of the act
- 10 of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known as the Human Services
- 11 <u>Code</u>.
- 12 <u>"Public health emergency." A declaration by the Governor of</u>
- 13 disaster emergency under 35 Pa.C.S. § 7301(c) (relating to
- 14 general authority of Governor).
- 15 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
