- 11 Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent
- 12 provisions of this title which are applicable to specific
- 13 provisions of this part, the following words and phrases when
- 14 used in this title shall have, unless the context clearly
- 15 indicates otherwise, the meanings given to them in this section:

- 17 "Person." Any individual, corporation, partnership, limited
- 18 <u>liability company, business trust, other association, government</u>
- 19 entity, not including the Commonwealth, estate, trust or

- 4 Section 2. Section 8301 of Title 42 is amended by adding a
- 5 subsection to read:
- 6 § 8301. Death action.

- 8 (e) Definition. -- As used in this section, the term
- 9 <u>"individual" means a human being, including an individual</u>
- 10 organism of the species homo sapiens from fertilization until
- 11 live birth.
- 12 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
