1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11 12	Amending the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), entitled "An act relating to insurance; amending, revising, and consolidating the law providing for the incorporation of insurance companies, and the regulation, supervision, and protection of home and foreign insurance companies, Lloyds associations, reciprocal and inter-insurance exchanges, and fire insurance rating bureaus, and the regulation and supervision of insurance carried by such companies, associations, and exchanges, including insurance carried by the State Workmen's Insurance Fund; providing penalties; and repealing existing laws," in casualty insurance, further providing for billing.
13	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
14	hereby enacts as follows:
15	Section 1. Section 635.7 of the act of May 17, 1921
16	(P.L.682, No.284), known as The Insurance Company Law of 1921,
17	is amended by adding a subsection to read:
18	Section 635.7. Billing* * *
19	(b.1) An insurer that sends a reimbursement payment directly
20	by mail to a covered person for medically necessary emergency
21	medical services provided by a nonnetwork EMS agency must
22	include a notice explaining the purpose of the payment. This

1 <u>notice must:</u>

2	(1) Clearly and conspicuously state the following:	
3	(i) The services for which the payment is being made,	
4	including the date of service and the name of the EMS agency	
5	that provided emergency medical services.	
6	(ii) The covered person is responsible for the bill for	
7	emergency medical services provided by the EMS agency.	
8	(iii) If the covered person has already paid the bill for	
9	the emergency medical services provided by the EMS agency in	
10	full, they can cash or deposit the reimbursement payment.	
11	(iv) The covered person has the option to discuss or	
12	negotiate the bill for emergency medical services with the EMS	
13	agency prior to making or forwarding a payment. The covered	
14	person shall not pay the EMS agency less than the amount they	
15	received from the insurer for that service.	
16	(v) Whether any payments, including the amounts, have been	
17	made by the insurer to the EMS agency related to this service.	
18	(vi) Any copayment, coinsurance or deductible that is the	
19	responsibility of the covered person under the covered person's	
20	health insurance policy.	
21	(2) Disclose the information required under paragraph (1) in	
22	type of a size no less than that of the surrounding text and in	
23	<u>no less than a font size of ten points.</u>	
24	(3) Be on its own page.	
25	(4) Be printed on red colored paper.	
26	(5) Include a heading, conspicuously placed at the top of	
27	the notice, with the words "STOP" in at least 24-point, boldface	
28	type and "Read this notice before depositing payment" in at	
29	<u>least 18-point, boldface type.</u>
