AN ACT

Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated 1 Statutes, in general provisions, further providing for 2 definitions; in licensing of drivers, further providing for 3 drivers required to be licensed, providing for undocumented immigrant driver's license invalid and further providing for 4 5 persons exempt from licensing and for carrying and exhibiting 6 driver's license on demand; in miscellaneous provisions, 7 further providing for the offense of homicide by vehicle, for 8 the offense of aggravated assault by vehicle, for the offense 9 of homicide by vehicle while driving under influence and for 10 the offense of aggravated assault by vehicle while driving 11 under influence; in enforcement, further providing for 12 impoundment for nonpayment of fines and vehicles or 13 combinations with a gross vehicle weight rating of 17,000 14 pounds or less; in penalties and disposition of fines, 15 further providing for subsequent convictions of certain 16 17 offenses; and imposing penalties.

18 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

19 hereby enacts as follows:

20 Section 1. Section 102 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania

22 § 102. Definitions.

23 Subject to additional definitions contained in subsequent 24 provisions of this title which are applicable to specific 25 provisions of this title, the following words and phrases when

used in this title shall have, unless the context clearly 1 2 indicates otherwise, the meanings given to them in this section: * * * 3 "Undocumented immigrant." An individual who does not prove 4 lawful presence within the United States. 5 "Undocumented immigrant driver's license." A class or type 6 7 of driver's license, permit or similar document issued by 8 another state exclusively to undocumented immigrants that authorizes the holder to operate a motor vehicle on public 9 10 highways. The term includes a driver's license issued by another state that is substantially the same as a driver's license 11 12 issued to individuals lawfully present in the United States but 13 has markings establishing that the license holder did not 14 exercise the option of providing proof of lawful presence. 15 * * * Section 2. Section 1501(a) and (d) of Title 75 are amended 16 and the section is amended by adding a subsection to read: 17 18 § 1501. Drivers required to be licensed. 19 (a) General rule.--No person, except those expressly 20 exempted, shall drive any motor vehicle upon a highway or public property in this Commonwealth unless the person has a driver's 21 license valid under the provisions of this chapter. As provided 22 under section 1501.1 (relating to undocumented immigrant 23 24 driver's license invalid), an undocumented immigrant driver's license shall not be considered a valid driver's license under 25 26 this chapter. As used in this subsection, the term "public property" includes, but is not limited to, driveways and parking 27 28 lots owned or leased by the Commonwealth, a political 29 subdivision or an agency or instrumentality of either. * * * 30

1 (d) Penalty.--[Any] Except as provided under subsection (e),_ any person violating subsection (a) is guilty of a summary 2 3 offense and shall, upon conviction, be sentenced to pay a fine of \$200, except that, if the person charged furnishes 4 satisfactory proof of having held a driver's license valid on 5 the last day of the preceding driver's license period and no 6 7 more than one year has elapsed from the last date for renewal, 8 the fine shall be \$25. No person charged with violating subsection (a) or (b) shall be convicted if the person produces 9 10 at the office of the issuing authority within 15 days of the 11 violation:

12 (1) a driver's license valid in this Commonwealth at the 13 time of the violation; or

14 (2) if the driver's license is lost, stolen, destroyed 15 or illegible, evidence that the driver was licensed at the 16 time of the violation.

17 <u>(e) Driving without a license.--A person convicted of a</u> 18 second or subsequent violation of subsection (a) within seven

22 <u>imprisonment for not more than six months, or both.</u>

A nonresident may only drive the class or classes of 20 vehicles in this Commonwealth for which the person is 21 licensed to drive in the person's home state or country 22 subject to all restrictions contained on the license.
