- The following words and phrases when used in this subchapter
- 7 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 8 <u>context clearly indicates otherwise:</u>
- 9 <u>"Department." The Department of Health of the Commonwealth.</u>
- 10 "Medication-induced movement disorders." A range of
- 11 <u>neurological conditions characterized by involuntary abnormal</u>
- 12 <u>movements associated with prolonged use of certain medications</u>
- 13 that are commonly used for the treatment of mental health
- 14 conditions.
- 15 "Program." The Medication-Induced Movement Disorders
- 16 <u>Screening Education Program established under section 56A22(a)</u>
- 17 (relating to program).
- 18 <u>§ 56A22</u>. Program.
- 19 (a) Establishment.--The department shall develop and conduct
- 20 the Medication-Induced Movement Disorders Screening Education
- 21 Program for residents of this Commonwealth.
- 22 (b) Consultation. -- The program shall be developed in
- 23 consultation with relevant agencies, including:
- 24 (1) The Office of Developmental Programs within the
- 25 <u>Department of Human Services.</u>
- 26 (2) The Office of Mental Health and Substance Abuse
- 27 <u>Services within the Department of Human Services.</u>
- 28 (3) The Department of Aging.
- 29 <u>(4) The Department of Drug and Alcohol Programs.</u>

- 2 (c) Components. -- The program shall include:
- 3 (1) The development of educational information on the

- 7 <u>materials for health care providers on clinical standards and</u>
- 8 <u>best practices for screening and treating medication-induced</u>
- 9 <u>movement disorders, including for services provided through</u>
- 10 telehealth. The guidance shall be:
- 11 (i) Informed by the American Psychiatric Association
- 12 <u>and other relevant and current professional society</u>
- 13 <u>practice guidelines.</u>
- 14 (ii) Developed in coordination with relevant health
- care provider groups.

- for individuals living with medication-induced movement
- disorders related to the treatment of mental health

- 22 (a) Development and availability. -- The department shall
- 23 develop electronic informational materials and shall make
- 24 available to the public and health care providers information
- 25 regarding symptoms of, screenings for and treatment of
- 26 medication-induced movement disorders.
- 27 (b) Posting and dissemination of information.--The
- 28 department shall:
- 29 <u>(1) Post the information under subsection (a) on the</u>
- 30 publicly accessible Internet website of the department.

- 2 <u>under section 56A22(c)(2) (relating to program) to health</u>
- 3 <u>care providers and facilities in this Commonwealth serving</u>
- 4 populations at high risk of medication-induced movement
- 5 disorders.
- 6 § 56A24. Regulations.
- 7 The department shall promulgate regulations necessary to
- 8 <u>implement and administer this subchapter.</u>
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
