- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- Section 1. The act of June 13, 1967 (P.L.31, No.21), known 7
- as the Human Services Code, is amended by adding a section to 8
- 9 read:
- 10 Section 443.13. Waivers to be Requested for Medical
- 11 Assistance. -- (a) The department shall request Federal approval
- 12 from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services of the
- 13 United States Department of Health and Human Services for a
- demonstration waiver under 42 U.S.C. § 1315 (relating to 14
- 15 demonstration projects) to enable the department to:
- 16 (1) Prohibit re-enrollment and deny eligibility for up to
- 17 six months for nondisabled, nonpregnant adults between nineteen
- 18 and sixty-four years of age who fail to report changes in
- circumstances that affect their eligibility for medical

- 1 assistance.
- 2 (2) Redetermine the medical assistance eligibility of an
- 3 individual covered under this waiver once every six months
- 4 <u>instead of once every twelve months.</u>
- 5 (3) Suspend the medical assistance requirement to renew
- 6 <u>eliqibility automatically based on available information and</u>
- 7 <u>suspend the medical assistance requirement to use a prepopulated</u>
- 8 renewal form.
- 9 (b) The following apply to approval:
- 10 (1) The department shall report receipt of approval of any
- 11 waiver submitted under subsection (a) to the following:
- 12 <u>(i) The Attorney General.</u>
- 13 <u>(ii) The Auditor General.</u>
- 14 <u>(iii) The Office of Inspector General.</u>
- 15 <u>(iv)</u> The members of the General Assembly.
- 16 (v) The Legislative Reference Bureau for publication in the
- 17 Pennsylvania Bulletin of the notice of approval of the waiver.
- 18 (2) The department shall adopt rules necessary to implement
- 19 and administer this section.
- 20 (c) If Federal approval for any waiver under subsection (a)
- 21 is denied, the department shall resubmit a request for approval
- 22 of the waiver within twenty-four months of the original denial
- 23 <u>and each subsequent denial thereafter.</u>
- 24 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
