1 2 3	Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, further providing for simple assault and for aggravated assault.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Sections 2701(b)(2) and 2702(a) and (b) of Title
7	18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended to

9	§ 2701. Simple assault.

11	(b) GradingSimple assault is a misdemeanor of the second
12	degree unless committed:

14	(2) against a child under 12 years of age by [an adult
15	21] <u>a person 18</u> years of age or older, in which case it is a
16	misdemeanor of the first degree.

1 § 2702. Aggravated assault.

2 (a) Offense defined.--A person is guilty of aggravated3 assault if he:

4 (1) attempts to cause serious bodily injury to another,
5 or causes such injury intentionally, knowingly or recklessly
6 under circumstances manifesting extreme indifference to the
7 value of human life;

8 (2) attempts to cause or intentionally, knowingly or 9 recklessly causes serious bodily injury to any of the 10 officers, agents, employees or other persons enumerated in 11 subsection (c) or to an employee of an agency, company or 12 other entity engaged in public transportation, while in the 13 performance of duty;

14 (3) attempts to cause or intentionally or knowingly 15 causes bodily injury to any of the officers, agents, 16 employees or other persons enumerated in subsection (c), in 17 the performance of duty;

18 (4) attempts to cause or intentionally or knowingly19 causes bodily injury to another with a deadly weapon;

20 attempts to cause or intentionally or knowingly (5) 21 causes bodily injury to a teaching staff member, school board 22 member or other employee, including a student employee, of 23 any elementary or secondary publicly-funded educational 24 institution, any elementary or secondary private school 25 licensed by the Department of Education or any elementary or 26 secondary parochial school while acting in the scope of his 27 or her employment or because of his or her employment 28 relationship to the school;

29 (6) attempts by physical menace to put any of the
30 officers, agents, employees or other persons enumerated in

subsection (c), while in the performance of duty, in fear of imminent serious bodily injury; [or]

(7) uses tear or noxious gas as defined in section
2708(b) (relating to use of tear or noxious gas in labor
disputes) or uses an electric or electronic incapacitation
device against any officer, employee or other person
enumerated in subsection (c) while acting in the scope of his
employment[.];

9 (8) attempts to cause or intentionally, knowingly or
 10 recklessly causes bodily injury to a child under four years
 11 of age; or

<u>(9) attempts to cause or intentionally, knowingly or</u>
 <u>recklessly causes serious bodily injury to a child under 12</u>
 <u>years of age.</u>

(b) Grading.--Aggravated assault under subsection (a)(1)
[and (2)], (2) and (9) is a felony of the first degree.
Aggravated assault under subsection (a)(3), (4), (5), (6) [and
[7)], (7) and (8) is a felony of the second degree.
