AN ACT

1 Amending Title 71 (State Government) of the Pennsylvania  
2 Consolidated Statutes, in retirement for State employees and  
3 officers, defining "campus police officer"; and further  
4 defining "superannuation age."

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. The definition of "superannuation age" in section  
8 5102 of Title 71 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is  
9 amended and the section is amended by adding a definition to  
10 read:

11 § 5102. Definitions.

12 The following words and phrases as used in this part, unless  
13 a different meaning is plainly required by the context, shall  
14 have the following meanings:

16 "Campus police officer." An employee of a university within  
17 the State System of Higher Education who is commissioned and  
18 trained as a police officer according to section 2416 of the act  
19 of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), known as The Administrative

1 Code of 1929.

3 "Superannuation age." For classes of service other than  
4 Class A-3 and Class A-4, any age upon accrual of 35 eligibility  
5 points or age 60, except for a member of the General Assembly,  
6 an enforcement officer, a correction officer, a psychiatric  
7 security aide, a Delaware River Port Authority policeman, a  
8 campus police officer or an officer of the Pennsylvania State  
9 Police, age 50, and, except for a member with Class G, Class H,  
10 Class I, Class J, Class K, Class L, Class M or Class N service,  
11 age 55 upon accrual of 20 eligibility points. For Class A-3 and  
12 Class A-4 service, any age upon attainment of a superannuation  
13 score of 92, provided the member has accrued 35 eligibility  
14 points, or age 65, or for park rangers or capitol police  
15 officers, age 55 with 20 years of service as a park ranger or  
16 capitol police officer, except for a member of the General  
17 Assembly, an enforcement officer, a correction officer, a  
18 psychiatric security aide, a Delaware River Port Authority  
19 policeman, a campus police officer or an officer of the  
20 Pennsylvania State Police, age 55. A vestee with Class A-3 or  
21 Class A-4 service credit attains superannuation age on the  
22 birthday the vestee attains the age resulting in a  
23 superannuation score of 92, provided that the vestee has at  
24 least 35 eligibility points, or attains another applicable  
25 superannuation age, whichever occurs first.

27 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
