AN ACT

1 Amending the act of August 9, 1955 (P.L.323, No.130), entitled,  
 2 as amended, "An act relating to counties of the first, third,  
 3 fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth classes; amending,  
 4 revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating  
 5 thereto; relating to imposition of excise taxes by counties,  
 6 including authorizing imposition of an excise tax on the  
 7 rental of motor vehicles by counties of the first class; and  
 8 providing for regional renaissance initiatives," in special  
 9 powers and duties of counties, providing for county humane  
 10 officers.

11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
 12 hereby enacts as follows:

13 Section 1. Article XIX of the act of August 9, 1955  
 14 (P.L.323, No.130), known as The County Code, is amended by  
 15 adding a subdivision to read:

16 (z.3) Other Powers and Duties

17 Section 1999j. County Humane Officers.--The county  
 18 commissioners may employ a county humane officer who shall be  
 19 authorized to enforce dog control as defined in the act of  
 20 December 7, 1982 (P.L.784, No.225), known as the Dog Law, and

1 animal cruelty laws of this Commonwealth as contained in 18  
2 Pa.C.S. § 5511 (relating to cruelty to animals). In order to be  
3 eligible for employment as a county humane officer, an  
4 individual must meet the training requirements contained in 22  
5 Pa.C.S. §§ 3712 (relating to training program) and 3713  
6 (relating to continuing education program).

7       Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
