AN ACT

1 Amending Title 57 (Notaries Public) of the Pennsylvania  
2 Consolidated Statutes, in revised uniform law on notarial  
3 acts, further providing for appointment and commission as  
4 notary public, qualifications and no immunity or benefit.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 321 of Title 57 of the Pennsylvania  
8 Consolidated Statutes is amended by adding a subsection to read:

9 § 321. Appointment and commission as notary public;  
10 qualifications; no immunity or benefit.

12 (b.1) Licensed attorneys.--A licensed attorney who satisfies  
13 the following is otherwise exempt from the requirements for  
14 appointment and commission as a notary public under subsection  
15 (a) and section 322:

16 (1) Completes and submits the prescribed application.

17 (2) Submits the nonrefundable filing fee.

18 (3) Submits proof of being a licensed attorney in good

1 standing with the Pennsylvania Supreme Court.

2 (4) Is not disqualified to receive a commission under  
3 section 323.

5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
