AN ACT

- Amending the act of July 7, 1980 (P.L.380, No.97), entitled "An 1 act providing for the planning and regulation of solid waste 2 storage, collection, transportation, processing, treatment, 3 and disposal; requiring municipalities to submit plans for municipal waste management systems in their jurisdictions; authorizing grants to municipalities; providing regulation of the management of municipal, residual and hazardous waste; 5 6 7 requiring permits for operating hazardous waste and solid 8 9 waste storage, processing, treatment, and disposal facilities; and licenses for transportation of hazardous 10 waste; imposing duties on persons and municipalities; 11 granting powers to municipalities; authorizing the 12 Environmental Quality Board and the Department of 13 Environmental Protection to adopt rules, regulations, 14 standards and procedures; granting powers to and imposing duties upon county health departments; providing remedies; prescribing penalties; and establishing a fund," in general 15 16 17 provisions, further providing for definitions; providing for 18 19 drill cuttings; and abrogating regulations. 20 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 21 hereby enacts as follows: 22 Section 1. Section 103 of the act of July 7, 1980 (P.L.380, 23 No.97), known as the Solid Waste Management Act, is amended by 24 adding a definition to read:

- 8 Section 2. The act is amended by adding an article to read:
- 9 ARTICLE V-A
- 10 DRILL CUTTINGS
- 11 <u>Section 501-A. Beneficial use, reuse and reclamation</u>
- 12 <u>authorized</u>.
- 13 The department shall allow for the beneficial use, reuse or
- 14 reclamation of drill cuttings, which shall include, but not be
- 15 <u>limited to, the following:</u>
- (1) Extraction or recovery of materials and compounds
- within drill cuttings, including critical minerals.
- 18 (2) Use as a raw material for another product, including
- as a raw material for aggregates, construction-related
- 20 materials or agricultural uses.
