## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 1 act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," in certification of teachers, further providing for continuing professional development and for 5 6 program of continuing professional and paraprofessional education. 8 9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Sections 1205.1 and 1205.2 of the act of March 11 12 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 13 1949, are amended by adding subsections to read: 14 Section 1205.1. Continuing Professional Development. --\* \* \* (c.5) A professional education plan shall include a program 15 to be completed annually by professional employes for 16 kindergarten through third grade, reading specialists, English 17 18 as a second language teachers and speech-language specialists that is a minimum of four (4) hours in length and provides 19 training in the screening, intervention, accommodation and use
