AN ACT

- Amending Title 75 (Vehicles) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated
 Statutes, further providing for immediate notice of accident
- 3 to police department.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 3746 of Title 75 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 3746. Immediate notice of accident to police department.
- 9 (a) General rule. -- The driver of a vehicle involved in an
- 10 accident shall immediately by the quickest means of
- 11 communication give notice to the nearest office of a duly
- 12 authorized police department if the accident involves:
- 13 (1) injury to or death of any person; or
- 14 (2) damage to any vehicle involved to the extent that it
- 15 cannot be driven under its own power in its customary manner
- 16 without further damage or hazard to the vehicle, other
- 17 traffic elements, or the roadway, and therefore requires
- 18 towing.

- 1 (b) Duty of occupant if driver disabled. -- Whenever the
- 2 driver of a vehicle is physically incapable of giving an
- 3 immediate notice of an accident as required in subsection (a)
- 4 and there is another occupant in the vehicle at the time of the
- 5 accident capable of doing so, the occupant shall make or cause
- 6 to be given the notice not given by the driver.
- 7 (c) Investigation by police officer.--Every accident
- 8 reported to a police department [required in this section] shall
- 9 be investigated by a police officer who shall physically report
- 10 to the scene of the accident and shall provide each driver a
- 11 signed statement that the accident was reported.
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
