## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain
- provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," in terms and courses of study,
- 6 providing for flexible instructional days.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 1506. Flexible Instructional Days.--(a) Within
- 13 thirty (30) days of the effective date of this section, the
- 14 department shall establish a standard application form for a
- 15 public school entity seeking approval to establish or renew a
- 16 program. The form shall be published on the department's
- 17 publicly accessible Internet website.
- 18 (b) The form under subsection (a) shall require the
- 19 <u>following information:</u>
- 20 (1) The procedure for a public school entity to notify

- 1 students, parents and professional employes that a flexible
- 2 instructional day is instituted.
- 3 (2) The procedure for instituting a flexible instructional
- 4 day, including whether the public school entity will use
- 5 <u>technology</u>.
- 6 (3) The responsibilities of professional employes and
- 7 <u>students during a flexible instructional day.</u>
- 8 (4) The procedure for identifying student participation
- 9 during a flexible instructional day for the purpose of enforcing
- 10 attendance under Article XIII.
- 11 (5) Instruction exemplary of a flexible instruction day in
- 12 each of the following:
- (i) English language arts in any grade from grades nine
- 14 through twelve.
- 15 (ii) Mathematics in any grade from grades nine through
- 16 twelve.
- 17 (iii) Science in any grade from grades nine through twelve.
- 18 (iv) Social Studies in any grade from grades nine through
- 19 twelve.
- 20 (v) English language arts in kindergarten or in any grade
- 21 from grades one through eight.
- 22 (vi) Mathematics in kindergarten or in any grade from grades
- 23 one through eight.
- 24 (6) Evidence of compliance with the Individuals with
- 25 Disabilities Education Act (Public Law 91-230, 20 U.S.C. § 1400
- 26 et seq.) during a flexible instructional day.
- 27 (7) Any additional information that the department deems
- 28 necessary to determine whether to approve or disapprove an
- 29 <u>application to establish or renew a program.</u>
- 30 (c) Within forty-five (45) days of receiving a public school

- 1 entity's application to establish or renew a program, the
- 2 department shall notify the public school entity that submitted
- 3 the application whether the department approved or denied the
- 4 <u>application</u>.
- 5 (d) An approved application under this section shall remain
- 6 valid for a period of thirty-six (36) months from the date the
- 7 <u>department approved the application.</u>
- 8 (e) As used in this section, the following words and phrases
- 9 shall have the meanings given to them in this subsection:
- 10 "Department" shall mean the Department of Education of the
- 11 Commonwealth.
- 12 "Flexible instructional day" shall mean a day that satisfies
- 13 all of the following:
- 14 (1) Fulfills one of the minimum required days of instruction
- 15 under section 1501.
- 16 (2) Prevents a school building from opening due to any of
- 17 the following:
- 18 (i) A disease epidemic.
- 19 (ii) A hazardous weather condition.
- 20 (iii) A law enforcement emergency.
- 21 (iv) The inoperability of school buses or other equipment
- 22 necessary to the public school entity's operation.
- 23 (v) Damage to a school building.
- 24 (vi) Another temporary circumstance due to utility failure
- 25 rendering the school building unfit for school use.
- 26 (3) Provides instruction to students.
- 27 "Program" shall mean a program that allows for a number of
- 28 flexible instructional days not to exceed five (5) days during a
- 29 <u>school year.</u>
- 30 "Public school entity" shall mean any of the following:

- 1 (1) A school district.
- 2 (2) An intermediate unit.
- 3 (3) An area vocational-technical school.
- 4 (4) A charter school or regional charter school, as defined
- 5 in section 1703-A.
- 6 "School building" shall mean a building owned by or under the
- 7 control of a public school entity where classes are taught or
- 8 extracurricular activities are conducted on a regular basis.
- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
