A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing the month of September 2023 as "National Recovery 2 Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, More than 22 million Americans are recovering from
- 4 substance use disorder; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Approximately 36 per 100,000 Pennsylvanians die from
- 6 substance use each year; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Although drug overdose rates in this Commonwealth
- 8 have recently declined, a reported 5,209 Pennsylvanians died
- 9 from February 2022 to February 2023; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Many Pennsylvanians are close to someone, whether
- 11 its their parents, children, siblings, neighbors, colleagues or
- 12 friends, working to overcome substance use and mental health
- 13 disorders; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Struggling individuals need support and resources
- 15 during their recovery process; and
- 16 WHEREAS, The recovery process can be difficult, especially
- 17 with finding housing, and having the necessary financial

- 1 resources, support from family and friends and a healthy
- 2 environment is critical to success; and
- 3 WHEREAS, By recognizing this month, we recommit our support
- 4 to the prevention, treatment and recovery of individuals with
- 5 substance use and mental health disorders; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Since 1989, "National Recovery Month" has been a
- 7 national observance held every September; and
- 8 WHEREAS, This observance promotes and supports new evidence-
- 9 based treatment and recovery practices, supports the recovery
- 10 community and recognizes the dedication of service providers and
- 11 communities who make recovery in all its forms possible; and
- 12 WHEREAS, We invite all residents of our Commonwealth to
- 13 participate in this observance by coming together and
- 14 celebrating individuals in recovery and offering support to
- 15 those still living with substance use and mental health
- 16 disorders; therefore be it
- 17 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives recognize the
- 18 month of September 2023 as "National Recovery Month" in
- 19 Pennsylvania.
