A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the 75th anniversary of The Builders Association of
2 Metropolitan Pittsburgh.

3 WHEREAS, The Builders Association of Metropolitan Pittsburgh
4 (BAMP) is one of the oldest builders associations in the
5 country; and

6 WHEREAS, BAMP represents over 500 small businesses that
7 strive to improve housing affordability, availability and
8 choice; and

9 WHEREAS, BAMP is recognized nationally for its advocacy of
10 safe and affordable housing as well as its educational and
11 consumer awareness efforts in promotion of its professional
12 members; and

13 WHEREAS, BAMP was a founding member of a group of local
14 associations that established the National Association of Home
15 Builders (NAHB) in 1942 and the Pennsylvania Builders

1 Association (PBA) in 1952; and

2 WHEREAS, BAMP established the Apartment Association of
3 Metropolitan Pittsburgh (AAMP) in 1971; and

4 WHEREAS, BAMP members, past and present, have a long history
5 of service to the industry and its association at the national,
6 State and local levels; and

7 WHEREAS, BAMP members adhere to a high code of ethics and
8 produce quality products for their customers in the
9 neighborhoods where they work and live; and

10 WHEREAS, BAMP has organized countless community service
11 projects throughout its 75 years of existence, lending its
12 members' expertise to construct or repair community assets as
13 well as helping to improve homes for neighbors in need of
14 assistance; therefore be it
