A RESOLUTION

- Designating the week of April 29 through May 6, 2019, as "Children's Mental Health Awareness Week" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Addressing the complex mental health needs of
- 4 children, youths and families is fundamental to the future of
- 5 our Commonwealth; and
- 6 WHEREAS, Poor mental health and mental health disorders
- 7 debilitate many and are an often overlooked health issue; and
- 8 WHEREAS, One in five children suffers from a mental disorder
- 9 and 79% of children from 6 to 17 years of age living with a
- 10 mental disorder do not receive mental health care; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Approximately 5% to 9% of children between 9 and 17
- 12 years of age live with severe emotional disturbances that cause
- 13 functional impairment in their daily lives; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Approximately 70% of children and young people who
- 15 experience a mental health problem have not had appropriate

- 1 interventions at a sufficiently early age; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Recognizing signs of poor mental health in children
- 3 is vitally important for successful child development; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Developing comprehensive, coordinated mental health
- 5 services for children, youths and families is a critical
- 6 responsibility of State government; and
- 7 WHEREAS, It is appropriate that we set aside one week each
- 8 year to direct our attention to our children's mental health and
- 9 well-being and our system of related resources and services;
- 10 therefore be it
- 11 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 12 week of April 29 through May 6, 2019, as "Children's Mental
- 13 Health Awareness Week" in Pennsylvania; and be it further
- 14 RESOLVED, That all residents, agencies and organizations
- 15 interested in meeting every child's mental health needs unite in
- 16 this observance in order to make our young constituents aware of
- 17 available resources and become successful and healthy adults.
