A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing the week of February 10, 2013, as "Pennsylvania  
2 Young Farmers' Association Week" in this Commonwealth.

3 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Chapter of the National Young  
4 Farmer Educational Association was founded in 1949; and

5 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania Young Farmers' Association's  
6 mission is to educate and promote the environmentally
