A RESOLUTION

1 Congratulating The Pennsylvania State University Women's Indoor
 2 Track and Field team for winning the Big Ten Championship on
 3 February 25, 2017.

4 WHEREAS, The Pennsylvania State University Women's Indoor
 5 Track and Field team won the 2017 Big Ten Indoor Track and Field
 6 Championship by posting two individual titles and claiming one
 7 relay to secure the Penn State Nittany Lions' fourth Big Ten
 8 Championship and the first since 2014; and

9 WHEREAS, The championship team tallied 96.5 points defeating
 10 its next closest competitor, Purdue, by 2.5 points; and

11 WHEREAS, The women's Big Ten championship, paired with the
 12 men's second-place finish, is the highest combined finish in
 13 Penn State track and field history; and

14 WHEREAS, Dannielle Gibson captured the women's triple jump
 15 title with a mark of 43' 4" (13.25m) to become only the second

1 Penn State athlete to win the event at the Big Ten Conference;
2 and

3 WHEREAS, Penn State recorded the first-place finish from
4 Danae Rivers in the 800-meter run; and

5 WHEREAS, Quenee Dale ran her fastest ever time in the 60
6 meter hurdles, posting a time of 8.21 seconds, ranking third in
7 team history; and

8 WHEREAS, In his third season as coach of the Nittany Lions,
9 John Gondak claimed his second conference title; and

10 WHEREAS, Coach John Gondak is the Big Ten Coach of the Year;
11 therefore be it

12 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives congratulate The
13 Pennsylvania State University Women's Indoor Track and Field
14 team for winning the Big Ten Championship of 2017.
