A RESOLUTION

- Designating September 3, 2013, as "University of Pittsburgh Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Founded in 1787, the University of Pittsburgh is one
- 4 of the oldest institutions of higher education in the United
- 5 States having celebrated its 225th anniversary in 2012; and
- 6 WHEREAS, With 24,990 undergraduate and 10,340 graduate
- 7 students across its Pittsburgh, Bradford, Greensburg, Johnstown
- 8 and Titusville campuses, the university is one of the most
- 9 distinguished comprehensive universities in the United States;
- 10 and
- 11 WHEREAS, As one of the country's leading research
- 12 universities, the University of Pittsburgh attracts more than
- 13 \$800,000,000 in research funding annually, supporting 28,000-
- 14 plus local jobs; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The University of Pittsburgh has also spun off

- 1 hundreds of companies in the last 15 years, driving Pittsburgh's
- 2 technology boom. Since 2000, University of Pittsburgh research
- 3 alone has resulted in 373 new patents, 628 new license
- 4 agreements and 67 new companies; and
- 5 WHEREAS, University of Pittsburgh students have earned
- 6 Rhodes, Goldwater, Marshall and Truman scholarships, among other
- 7 highly competitive national and international scholarships; and
- 8 WHEREAS, University of Pittsburgh alumni have pioneered MRI
- 9 and TV, won Nobel and Pulitzer prizes, led corporations and
- 10 universities, served in government and the military, conquered
- 11 Hollywood and The New York Times bestsellers list and won Super
- 12 Bowls and NBA championships; therefore be it
- 13 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate
- 14 September 3, 2013, as "University of Pittsburgh Day" in
- 15 Pennsylvania.
