A RESOLUTION

1 2 3	Directing the Department of Health of the Commonwealth to study the impact of smart phones on children's health and development.
4	WHEREAS, Sixty percent of children are exposed to smart
5	phones prior to five years of age; and
6	WHEREAS, Approximately 80% of teenagers own smart phones,
7	with half of all youth in the United States owning a personal
8	phone by 11 years of age; and
9	WHEREAS, The American Academy of Pediatrics suggests that
10	children under 18 to 24 months of age refrain from screen time;
11	and
12	WHEREAS, Additionally, children two to five years of age
13	should have a limited screen time of no more than one
14	consecutive hour per day; and
15	WHEREAS, According to psychologists, a decline in children's
16	mental health, including anxiety, depression, self-harm and
17	suicide, is associated with the growing use of smart phones,
18	which has increased access to social media; and

1 WHEREAS, Data has demonstrated that smart phone use negatively affects sleeping patterns, making it increasingly 2 3 difficult for young people to fall asleep, which leads to reduced alertness and cognitive functioning; and 4 5 WHEREAS, It is vitally important to ensure that Pennsylvania's youths are protected from potential harms 6 associated with smart phones; therefore be it 7 8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives direct the Department of Health of the Commonwealth to study the impact of 9 10 smart phones on children's health and development; and be it 11 further 12 RESOLVED, That the Department of Health issue a report of its 13 findings on its Internet website, share the report with the 14 General Assembly, recommend alternatives and consider requirements for pediatricians to provide the department's 15 16 quidelines to parents within one year of the passage of this
