A RESOLUTION

Designating the week of September 8 through 14, 2013, as 1 "Nephrology Nurses Week" and asking all residents of this 2 Commonwealth to join in honoring the nephrology nurses who 3 4 care for patients with kidney disease. 5 WHEREAS, Nearly 20 million Americans suffer from kidney 6 disease and every year many Pennsylvania residents, including 7 children, adults and elderly individuals, are diagnosed with 8 kidney disease; and 9 WHEREAS, The depth and breadth of the nephrology nursing 10 profession meet the different and emerging kidney disease and 11 other health care needs of the population of this Commonwealth; 12 and 13 WHEREAS, The American Nephrology Nurses' Association is 14 working to advance quality care for Americans with kidney

15 disease before they suffer complete organ failure, to increase

16 awareness in local communities, to positively influence patient

outcomes and to keep nephrology nurses abreast of the latest
treatments and kidney-related research; and

3 WHEREAS, Nephrology nurses function as educators, direct 4 caregivers and coordinators to help patients manage their lives 5 while effectively dealing with health issues; and

6 WHEREAS, As the number of new patients diagnosed with kidney 7 disease has doubled in each of the last two decades, the demand 8 for nephrology nurses will expand, as this trend is expected to 9 continue; and

10 WHEREAS, More qualified nephrology nurses will be needed to meet the increasingly complex needs of patients who are 11 12 experiencing or are at risk for kidney disease; and 13 WHEREAS, Along with the American Nephrology Nurses' 14 Association, Keystone Chapter 110 has declared the week of September 8 through 14, 2013, as Nephrology Nurses Week with the 15 theme "Nephrology Nurses Take Action" to celebrate and honor the 16 17 unselfish work nephrology nurses perform each day to maintain 18 the health of thousands of individuals with kidney disease; 19 therefore be it

20 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the 21 week of September 8 through 14, 2013, as "Nephrology Nurses 22 Week" and ask all residents of this Commonwealth to join in 23 honoring the nephrology nurses who care for patients with kidney 24 disease; and be it further

RESOLVED, That the residents of this Commonwealth celebrate nephrology nurses' efforts to advance patient care and reduce the incidence of kidney disease and show appreciation for nephrology nurses not just during this week but at every opportunity throughout the year.
