7 Representatives for more than 10 years, working both in district

1 Mike Vereb from 2010 to 2015 and helped craft several bills that  
2 were enacted into law and continue to positively impact the  
3 lives of Pennsylvanians; and

4 WHEREAS, Brian was instrumental in helping Representative  
5 Vereb usher House Bill 1610 through the General Assembly in  
6 2012, resulting in the enactment of the Sudden Cardiac Arrest  
7 Prevention Act that establishes standards for preventing sudden  
8 cardiac arrest and death in student athletes; and

9 WHEREAS, Brian was known for his great sense of humor and the  
10 camaraderie he shared with his colleagues and friends within and  
11 outside the House of Representatives; and

12 WHEREAS, Brian earned his undergraduate degree from Villanova  
13 University and was a devoted Wildcats basketball fan; therefore

15 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives note with deep  
16 sadness the passing of Brian Kadunc and extend heartfelt  
17 condolences to his father, James Kadunc; mother, Catherine  
18 Kadunc; sister, Melinda Sgariglia; and his extended family; and
