A RESOLUTION

- Designating the month of September 2024 as "Healthy Hunger-Free Kids Month" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Hunger is a reality for many students, with one in
- 4 eight children in this Commonwealth experiencing severe hunger;
- 5 and
- 6 WHEREAS, As many as 13 million children in the United States
- 7 live in food-insecure homes, where there is not enough food for
- 8 every family member; and
- 9 WHEREAS, We are fighting not only hunger in our children, but
- 10 also millions of tons of food waste; and
- 11 WHEREAS, An average of 28.6 million lunches are served daily
- 12 across the nation; and
- 13 WHEREAS, An estimated 530,000 tons of food and 45 million
- 14 gallons of milk are wasted per year in school cafeterias; and
- 15 WHEREAS, The Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act went into effect
- 16 in December 2010; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Under the act, students must take a certain number

- 1 of items, including a fruit or vegetable; and
- 2 WHEREAS, Schools must serve the same size meals to
- 3 kindergarteners, for whom the lunch might be too much, and older
- 4 students, for whom it might not be enough; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Research shows that many students are throwing the
- 6 required healthier options into the trash; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Share tables are a place where students can return
- 8 unopened food and drinks that they choose not to consume so that
- 9 other students may take additional helpings at no cost; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Share tables are an excellent way for child
- 11 nutrition programs to reduce food waste and provide nutrition
- 12 for hungry kids; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Share tables are an innovative strategy to encourage
- 14 the consumption of nutritious foods and reduce food waste;
- 15 therefore be it
- 16 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 17 month of September 2024 as "Healthy Hunger-Free Kids Month" in
- 18 Pennsylvania.
