## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing October 9, 2024, as "Ageism Awareness Day" in Pennsylvania.
- 3 WHEREAS, Ageism refers to the stereotypes, prejudice and
- 4 discrimination toward others based on age; and
- 5 WHEREAS, More than 90% of older adults say they regularly
- 6 experience some form of ageism; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The fastest growing demographic in this Commonwealth
- 8 is older adults 85 years of age and older; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Ageism toward older adults affects their health and
- 10 longevity, financial well-being and the economy of Pennsylvania;

- 12 WHEREAS, Creating awareness of and actively preventing ageism
- 13 in education, employment, housing and health care benefits all
- 14 individuals; and
- 15 WHEREAS, It is up to all of us to ensure that older adults
- 16 are respected and portrayed as capable, competent, effective and

- 2 WHEREAS, Ageism awareness and preventing ageism is beneficial
