## A RESOLUTION

Designating the week of September 6 through 12, 2020, as 1 "Idiopathic Pulmonary Fibrosis Research and Awareness Week" 2 in Pennsylvania to increase awareness and understanding of 3 idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis. 5 WHEREAS, Idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis is a debilitating and generally fatal disease marked by progressive scarring of the 6 lungs, causing an irreversible loss of the lung tissue's ability 7 to transport oxygen; and 8 9 WHEREAS, Idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis progresses quickly, often causing disability or death within three to five years; 10 11 and WHEREAS, Idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis is the most common 12 form of interstitial lung disease; and 13 WHEREAS, There is no proven cause of idiopathic pulmonary 14 15 fibrosis and it is often misdiagnosed or under diagnosed; and 16 WHEREAS, Idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis is five times more common than cystic fibrosis and Lou Gehriq's disease yet the 17 18 disease remains virtually unknown and receives a fraction of the

- 2 WHEREAS, More than 132,000 United States' citizens have
- 3 idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis and more than 50,000 new cases are
- 4 diagnosed each year; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Forty thousand people die each year due to
- 6 idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis, the same number as breast cancer;
- 7 and
- 8 WHEREAS, Approximately 7,000 Pennsylvanians suffer from
- 9 idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis; and
- 10 WHEREAS, This Commonwealth has become a leader in research
- 11 and treatment of idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis, with more than
- 12 15% of all lung transplants in the United States performed in
- 13 Pennsylvania hospitals; and
- 14 WHEREAS, COVID-19 poses a great threat to patients with
- 15 idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis due to the average age of
- 16 diagnosis and the vulnerability of their lungs and immune
- 17 systems; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Increased research, awareness and detection of
- 19 idiopathic pulmonary fibrosis is needed; therefore be it
- 20 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives designate the
- 21 week of September 6 through 12, 2020, as "Idiopathic Pulmonary
- 22 Fibrosis Research and Awareness Week" in Pennsylvania to
- 23 increase awareness and understanding of idiopathic pulmonary
- 24 fibrosis to support improved diagnosis and treatment.
