## A RESOLUTION

- Directing the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee to study the fiscal impact of electing the Insurance Commissioner of
- 3 the Commonwealth by popular vote.
- 4 WHEREAS, The Constitution of Pennsylvania currently provides
- 5 for the appointment of the Insurance Commissioner by the
- 6 Governor; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The Insurance Commissioner has the ability to
- 8 dramatically impact the lives of citizens through policy
- 9 decisions regarding automobile, health, homeowner's and other
- 10 types of insurance; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Many other states currently elect their Insurance
- 12 Commissioner by popular vote; and
- 13 WHEREAS, Legislation has been introduced in the General
- 14 Assembly during past sessions to provide for the Statewide
- 15 election of the Insurance Commissioner; and
- 16 WHEREAS, In the current legislative session, legislation has
- 17 been introduced to amend the Constitution of Pennsylvania to
- 18 provide for the election of the Insurance Commissioner in the

- 1 same election cycle as the election of the Auditor General and
- 2 the State Treasurer; and
- 3 WHEREAS, The General Assembly and the public would benefit
- 4 from having objective information in the debate to elect the
- 5 Insurance Commissioner; therefore be it
- 6 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives direct the
- 7 Legislative Budget and Finance Committee to study the financial
- 8 impact on the Commonwealth and individual counties in providing
- 9 for the election of the Insurance Commissioner in the same
- 10 election cycle as the election of the Auditor General and the
- 11 State Treasurer; and be it further
- 12 RESOLVED, That the Legislative Budget and Finance Committee
- 13 report all findings on this matter to the General Assembly no
- 14 later than six months after the adoption of this resolution.
