11	(e.1) Grant Evaluation Committee The Grant Evaluation
12	Committee is established within the department and the following
13	shall apply:
14	(1) The Grant Evaluation Committee shall:
15	(i) Review and evaluate applications for grants
16	provided under this subchapter.
17	(ii) Provide recommendations on the use of funds
18	under this subchapter to the Adjutant General.

- 1 (2) The review and evaluation of applications for grants 2 provided under this subchapter and the making of recommendations for the use of funding under this subchapter 3 4 performed by individuals pursuant to the statement of policy for the maintenance and use of the fund required under 5 6 subsection (e) prior to the effective date of this subsection shall be performed by the Grant Evaluation Committee as 7 8 provided under paragraph (1). 9 (3) The Grant Evaluation Committee shall be comprised of members appointed by the Adjutant General, the chairperson 10 and minority chairperson of the Veterans Affairs and 11 Emergency Preparedness Committee of the Senate and the 12 chairperson and minority chairperson of the Veterans Affairs 13 14 and Emergency Preparedness Committee of the House of 15 Representatives.
