A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth
- of Pennsylvania, providing for the general appropriation
- 3 bill.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby resolves as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 7 Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with Article XI:
- 8 (1) That Article III be amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 11.1. General appropriation bill.
- 10 (a) The general appropriation bill for a fiscal year shall
- 11 <u>be introduced in the General Assembly prior to or on the first</u>
- 12 Tuesday of the month following the Governor's budget address.
- 13 (b) On the first Tuesday of the month following the
- 14 Governor's budget address, and on the first Tuesday of each
- 15 subsequent month until the general appropriation bill is enacted
- 16 into law, the majority and minority chairpersons of the
- 17 Appropriations Committee of the Senate, the majority and
- 18 minority chairpersons of the Appropriations Committee of the

- 1 House of Representatives and a designee of the Governor's Office
- 2 <u>shall present a joint report to the General Assembly detailing</u>
- 3 the current status of the budget negotiations between the
- 4 General Assembly and the Governor's Office concerning the
- 5 general appropriation bill and any related revenue-generating
- 6 bills. The first report shall include the number of meetings
- 7 concerning the budget negotiations held between the General_
- 8 Assembly and the Governor's Office, and any subsequent report
- 9 shall include the number of meetings that have occurred since
- 10 <u>the previous report.</u>
- 11 Section 2. (a) Upon the first passage by the General
- 12 Assembly of this proposed constitutional amendment, the
- 13 Secretary of the Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to
- 14 comply with the advertising requirements of section 1 of Article
- 15 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the
- 16 required advertisements to two newspapers in every county in
- 17 which such newspapers are published in sufficient time after
- 18 passage of this proposed constitutional amendment.
- 19 (b) Upon the second passage by the General Assembly of this
- 20 proposed constitutional amendment, the Secretary of the
- 21 Commonwealth shall proceed immediately to comply with the
- 22 advertising requirements of section 1 of Article XI of the
- 23 Constitution of Pennsylvania and shall transmit the required
- 24 advertisements to two newspapers in every county in which such
- 25 newspapers are published in sufficient time after passage of
- 26 this proposed constitutional amendment. The Secretary of the
- 27 Commonwealth shall submit this proposed constitutional amendment
- 28 to the qualified electors of this Commonwealth at the first
- 29 primary, general or municipal election which meets the
- 30 requirements of and is in conformance with section 1 of Article

- 1 XI of the Constitution of Pennsylvania and which occurs at least
- 2 three months after the proposed constitutional amendment is
- 3 passed by the General Assembly.
