The definition of "advanced practice professional" in section 2 of the act of May 31, 2018 (P.L.123, 7 No.25), known as the Outpatient Psychiatric Oversight Act, is 8 amended to read: Section 2. Definitions. 10 11 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall 12 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the 13 context clearly indicates otherwise: 14 "Advanced practice professional." A person who: 15 holds a current Pennsylvania license as a (i) 16 certified registered nurse practitioner with a mental health certification; or 17

(ii) obtains a mental health certification within

4	(2) [(i)] holds a current Pennsylvania license as a
5	physician assistant [with a] who does one of the

7	(i) Holds a mental health certification[; or].
8	(ii) [obtains] <u>Obtains</u> a mental health certification
9	within two years of being hired by an outpatient
_0	psychiatric clinic or within two years of the effective

2	(iii) Has a written agreement with a psychiatrist.
