Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, in minors, further providing for 2 misrepresentation of age to secure liquor or malt or brewed 3 beverages, for purchase, consumption, possession or 4 transportation of liquor or malt or brewed beverages and for 5 carrying a false identification card. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Sections 6307(b), 6308(b) and 6310.3(b) of Title 18 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes are amended and the 10 11 sections are amended by adding subsections to read: 12 § 6307. Misrepresentation of age to secure liquor or malt or 13 brewed beverages. 14 (b) Minimum penalty. -- [A] In addition to the penalty imposed 15 16 under subsection (b.1), a person who is convicted of violating 17 subsection (a) may be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$500 for the first violation and not more than \$1,000 for 18 19 subsequent violations. No court shall have the authority to

suspend any sentence as defined in this section.
