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AN ACT

1 Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An  
2 act relating to the public school system, including certain  
3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial  
4 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the  
5 laws relating thereto," in reimbursements by Commonwealth and  
6 between school districts, further providing for payments on  
7 account of pupils enrolled in career and technical  
8 curriculums.

9 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
10 hereby enacts as follows:

11 Section 1. Section 2502.8(b) of the act of March 10, 1949  
12 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is  
13 amended by adding a clause to read:

14 Section 2502.8. Payments on Account of Pupils Enrolled in  
15 Career and Technical Curriculums.--\* \* \*

16 (b) For the 1981-1982 school year through the 1984-1985  
17 school year, each school district so entitled shall be paid, in  
18 addition to any other subsidy to which it is entitled, an amount  
19 on account of resident pupils enrolled in career and technical  
20 curriculums; for the 1985-1986 school year through the 1999-2000

1 school year, each school district and area career and technical  
2 school shall be paid an amount on account of students enrolled  
3 in career and technical curriculums; for the 2000-2001 school  
4 year and each school year thereafter, each school district, area  
5 career and technical school and charter school shall be paid an  
6 amount on account of students enrolled in career and technical  
7 curriculums, determined as follows:

9 (6) The data used for the calculations made in this section  
10 shall be fixed as of the first day of June preceding the school  
11 year in which the allocation occurs. Data fixed on the first day  
12 of June shall be revised by the Department of Education if it is  
13 subsequently found to be incorrect.

15 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
