AN ACT

1 Amending Title 71 (State Government) of the Pennsylvania
2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for definitions.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. The definition of "superannuation age" in section
6 5102 of Title 71 of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is
7 amended and the section is amended by adding a definition to
8 read:

9 § 5102. Definitions.

10 The following words and phrases as used in this part, unless
11 a different meaning is plainly required by the context, shall
12 have the following meanings:

13 * * *

14 "Commonwealth firefighter or firefighter instructor." An
15 employee of the Commonwealth engaged in any of the following:

16 (1) Specialized structural and aircraft firefighting.

17 (2) Fire prevention or fire inspection of buildings or
18 aircraft owned or maintained by the Commonwealth.

1 (3) Specialized training of emergency service and allied
2 professionals at the Pennsylvania State Fire Academy.

4 "Superannuation age." For classes of service other than
5 Class A-3 and Class A-4, any age upon accrual of 35 eligibility
6 points or age 60, except for a member of the General Assembly,
7 an enforcement officer, a correction officer, a psychiatric
8 security aide, a Delaware River Port Authority policeman, a
9 Commonwealth firefighter or firefighter instructor or an officer
10 of the Pennsylvania State Police, age 50, and, except for a
11 member with Class G, Class H, Class I, Class J, Class K, Class
12 L, Class M or Class N service, age 55 upon accrual of 20
13 eligibility points. For Class A-3 and Class A-4 service, any age
14 upon attainment of a superannuation score of 92, provided the
15 member has accrued 35 eligibility points, or age 65, or for park
16 rangers or capitol police officers, age 55 with 20 years of
17 service as a park ranger or capitol police officer, except for a
18 member of the General Assembly, an enforcement officer, a
19 correction officer, a psychiatric security aide, a Delaware
20 River Port Authority policeman or an officer of the Pennsylvania
21 State Police, age 55. A vestee with Class A-3 or Class A-4
22 service credit attains superannuation age on the birthday the
23 vestee attains the age resulting in a superannuation score of
24 92, provided that the vestee has at least 35 eligibility points,
25 or attains another applicable superannuation age, whichever
26 occurs first.

28 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
