13	5531 (relating to no limitation), a civil action against a
14	person or other entity for damages resulting from a violation of
15	any of the following provisions of 18 Pa.C.S. (relating to
16	crimes and offenses) may be commenced at any time during the
17	life of the victim if:
18	(1) the victim was less than 14 years of age at the time
19	of commission of the criminal offense; and

2	effective date of this section:
