7	hereby enacts as follows:
8	Section 1. The act of December 17, 1959 (P.L.1913, No.694),
9	known as the Equal Pay Law, is amended by adding a section to

11	Section 3.1. Pay Ranges(a) An employer shall provide the
12	pay range and the factors the employer considers in setting pay
13	ranges to:
14	(1) An applicant for a position offered in a job posting.
15	(2) An employe who is a candidate for a position offered as
16	<u>an internal transfer or promotion.</u>
17	(b) If no pay range exists, an employer shall provide the
18	minimum wage or salary set by the employer before the employer
19	posted the position or offered an internal transfer or

1 promotion.

(c) Upon hiring an employe, and annually thereafter, an 2 employer shall provide the employe, in writing, the pay range 3 for the employe's job title and for jobs within the employer's 4 business that are substantially similar with respect to the 5 skill, effort and responsibility required to perform the jobs 6 and the conditions under which the jobs are performed. 7 (d) This section applies to employers with fifteen or more 8 9 employes.

10 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
