## AN ACT

Amending the act of December 19, 1988 (P.L.1262, No.156), entitled "An act providing for the licensing of eligible 2 organizations to conduct games of chance, for the licensing 3 of persons to distribute games of chance, for the registration of manufacturers of games of chance, and for suspensions and revocations of licenses and permits; requiring records; providing for local referendum by electorate; and prescribing penalties, " in games of chance, 8 providing for payment and for online raffle sales; and abrogating a regulation. 10 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 12 hereby enacts as follows: 13 Section 1. The act of December 19, 1988 (P.L.1262, No.156), 14 known as the Local Option Small Games of Chance Act, is amended 15 by adding sections to read: Section 301.2. Payment. 16 17 (a) Methods.--18 (1) Except as provided under paragraph (2) and 19 notwithstanding any other provision of law, a licensed 20 eligible organization may accept payment via credit card, debit card, mobile payment services or other electronic 21

- 1 payment method for the playing of games of chance.
- 2 (2) A licensee under Chapter 9 may not accept mobile
- 3 payment services for the playing of games of chance.
- 4 (b) Definitions.--As used in this section, the following
- 5 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 6 subsection unless the context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 7 "Mobile payment service." A service in which a money payment
- 8 is made electronically through a money transfer service, such as
- 9 <u>Venmo, Paypal, Cash App or an equivalent money transfer service.</u>
- 10 Section 303.2. Online raffle sales.
- 11 (a) Operations. -- Notwithstanding any other provision of this
- 12 act, a licensed eligible organization may conduct and reveal the
- 13 <u>winner of raffles through a publicly accessible Internet</u>
- 14 website, social media platform or mobile application.
- 15 (b) Payments. -- A licensed eligible organization may accept
- 16 electronic payment via credit card, debit card, mobile
- 17 electronic payment application or other electronic payment
- 18 method for the purchase of a raffle ticket, provided that the
- 19 organization:
- 20 (1) employs a method to detect the physical location of
- 21 an individual who buys a ticket for the raffle. The
- 22 organization may not accept payment from an individual who is
- located outside of this Commonwealth;
- (2) employs a method to verify that the individual who
- 25 buys a raffle ticket is at least 18 years of age. The
- 26 organization may not accept payment from an individual under
- 27 18 years of age; and
- 28 (3) does not violate the provisions of 31 U.S.C. Ch. 53
- 29 <u>Subch. IV (relating to prohibition on funding of unlawful</u>
- 30 Internet gambling).

- 1 (c) Applicability. -- The following sections shall not apply
- 2 to online raffle sales:
- 3 <u>(1) Section 302.</u>
- 4 (2) Section 303(b).
- 5 <u>(3) Section 907.</u>
- 6 Section 2. The provisions of 61 Pa. Code § 901.506 are
- 7 abrogated insofar as they are inconsistent with the addition of
- 8 section 301.2 of the act.
- 9 Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
