## AN ACT

- 1 Providing for a report by the Department of State on complaints 2 relating to elections.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. Short title.
- 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Election
- 7 Report Act.
- 8 Section 2. Definitions.
- 9 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall
- 10 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 11 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- 12 "Department." The Department of State of the Commonwealth.
- "Election." Any election held under the act of June 3, 1937
- 14 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the Pennsylvania Election Code.
- 15 Section 3. Report.
- 16 (a) General rule. -- The department shall submit a report
- 17 regarding how the following complaints by individuals registered
- 18 to vote in this Commonwealth relating to an election were

- 1 investigated:
- 2 (1) Complaints submitted to the Bureau of Commissions,
- 3 Elections and Legislation of the department regarding
- 4 violations of 52 U.S.C. Ch. 209 (relating to election
- 5 administration improvement).
- 6 (2) Complaints submitted to the department through the
- 7 department's formal election complaint publicly accessible
- 8 Internet website.
- 9 (3) Complaints submitted to the department through the
- 10 publicly accessible election day hotline.
- 11 (b) Contents. -- The information in the report under
- 12 subsection (a) shall include the complaint, polling precinct and
- 13 county in which the complaint originated, what actions the
- 14 department took to investigate the complaint and the outcome of
- 15 the investigation. Anonymous complaints shall be excluded from
- 16 the report.
- 17 (c) Submission. -- Within 45 days of the election, the
- 18 department shall submit a report detailing complaints received
- 19 to the following:
- 20 (1) The President pro tempore of the Senate.
- 21 (2) The Majority Leader and the Minority Leader of the
- 22 Senate.
- 23 (3) The Speaker of the House of Representatives.
- 24 (4) The Majority Leader and the Minority Leader of the
- 25 House of Representatives.
- 26 (5) The Secretary of the Senate.
- 27 (6) The Chief Clerk of the House of Representatives.
- 28 (7) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the
- 29 State Government Committee of the Senate.
- 30 (8) The chairperson and minority chairperson of the

- 1 State Government Committee of the House of Representatives.
- 2 Section 4. Effective date.
- 3 This act shall take effect immediately.
