AN ACT

Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), entitled "An act relating to the finances of the State government; providing for cancer control, prevention and research, for 3 ambulatory surgical center data collection, for the Joint Underwriting Association, for entertainment business financial management firms, for private dam financial 6 assurance and for reinstatement of item vetoes; providing for 7 the settlement, assessment, collection, and lien of taxes, 8 9 bonus, and all other accounts due the Commonwealth, the 10 collection and recovery of fees and other money or property due or belonging to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, 11 including escheated property and the proceeds of its sale, 12 the custody and disbursement or other disposition of funds 13 and securities belonging to or in the possession of the 14 15 Commonwealth, and the settlement of claims against the Commonwealth, the resettlement of accounts and appeals to the 16 courts, refunds of moneys erroneously paid to the Commonwealth, auditing the accounts of the Commonwealth and 17 18 all agencies thereof, of all public officers collecting 19 moneys payable to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, 20 and all receipts of appropriations from the Commonwealth, 21 authorizing the Commonwealth to issue tax anticipation notes 22 23 to defray current expenses, implementing the provisions of section 7(a) of Article VIII of the Constitution of 24 Pennsylvania authorizing and restricting the incurring of 25 certain debt and imposing penalties; affecting every 26 department, board, commission, and officer of the State 27 government, every political subdivision of the State, and 28 29 certain officers of such subdivisions, every person, association, and corporation required to pay, assess, or 30 31 collect taxes, or to make returns or reports under the laws 32 imposing taxes for State purposes, or to pay license fees or other moneys to the Commonwealth, or any agency thereof, 33 every State depository and every debtor or creditor of the 34

- initiative; and making an appropriation.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. The act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), known
- 6 as The Fiscal Code, is amended by adding an article to read:
- 7 ARTICLE I-K
- 8 FOHC PRIMARY CARE WORKFORCE INITIATIVE
- 9 <u>Section 101-K. Definitions.</u>
- 10 The following words and phrases when used in this article
- 11 shall have the meanings given to them in this section unless the
- 12 context clearly indicates otherwise:
- "Accredited medical college." As follows:
- 14 (1) As defined under section 2 of the act of December
- 20, 1985 (P.L.457, No.112), known as the Medical Practice Act
- 16 of 1985.
- 17 (2) An osteopathic medical college as defined under
- 18 section 2 of the act of October 5, 1978 (P.L.1109, No.261),
- 19 known as the Osteopathic Medical Practice Act.
- 20 (3) An institution of higher education that meets the
- 21 requirements of section 6.1 of the act of May 22, 1951
- 22 (P.L.317, No.69), known as The Professional Nursing Law.
- 23 (4) A program at an institution of higher education that
- 24 meets the requirements of 49 Pa. Code § 18.131 (relating to
- recognized educational programs/standards).
- 26 (5) A program at an institution of higher education that
- 27 meets the requirements of 49 Pa. Code § 25.151 (relating to
- 28 <u>certification of physician assistant educational programs).</u>
- 29 (6) An institution of higher education that meets the
- 30 requirements of section 3(c) of the act of May 1, 1933
- 31 (P.L.216, No.76), known as The Dental Law.

- 1 <u>"Certified registered nurse practitioner." An individual</u>
- 2 licensed as a certified registered nurse practitioner under The
- 3 <u>Professional Nursing Law.</u>
- 4 "Dentist." An individual licensed in the practice of
- 5 dentistry under The Dental Law.
- 6 <u>"Department." The Department of Health of the Commonwealth.</u>
- 7 "FQHC." A federally qualified health center as defined under
- 8 42 U.S.C. § 1395x(aa)(4) (relating to definitions).
- 9 "Physician." A medical doctor licensed under the Medical
- 10 Practice Act of 1985 or a doctor of osteopathic medicine
- 11 <u>licensed under the Osteopathic Medical Practice Act.</u>
- 12 "Physician assistant." An individual licensed as a physician
- 13 <u>assistant under the Medical Practice Act of 1985 or the</u>
- 14 Osteopathic Medical Practice Act.
- 15 "Preceptor." A primary care practitioner supervising or
- 16 <u>directing a student enrolled in the FQHC primary care workforce</u>
- 17 initiative.
- 18 "Primary care practitioner." A physician, physician
- 19 <u>assistant</u>, <u>certified registered nurse practitioner</u>, <u>dentist or</u>
- 20 psychiatrist employed by a FQHC.
- 21 "Student." An individual currently satisfying clinical
- 22 rotation from an accredited medical college at a FQHC and
- 23 <u>enrolled in the FQHC primary care workforce initiative.</u>
- 24 <u>Section 102-K. FQHC primary care workforce initiative.</u>
- 25 (a) Establishment.--Within one year of the effective date of
- 26 this subsection, the department shall establish the FQHC primary
- 27 care workforce initiative within the department.
- 28 (b) Purpose. -- The FQHC primary care workforce initiative
- 29 <u>shall be a voluntary program to offer a clinical rotation</u>
- 30 placement at a FQHC for a student attending an accredited

- 1 medical college.
- 2 (c) Appropriation. -- From money received by the Commonwealth
- 3 under the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (Public Law 117-2,
- 4 <u>135 Stat. 4), the sum of \$2,500,000 is appropriated to the</u>
- 5 department for grants awarded under this section. Money shall
- 6 not be distributed until the establishment of the FQHC primary
- 7 <u>care workforce initiative by the department.</u>
- 8 (d) Grant awards. -- Grants awarded by the department under
- 9 this section shall be equal amounts to each FQHC in this
- 10 Commonwealth that is enrolled in the FQHC primary care workforce
- 11 <u>initiative as a stipend to support a preceptor or student.</u>
- 12 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
