## AN ACT

Amending the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, No.2), entitled "An act relating to tax reform and State taxation by codifying 2 and enumerating certain subjects of taxation and imposing 3 taxes thereon; providing procedures for the payment, 5 collection, administration and enforcement thereof; providing for tax credits in certain cases; conferring powers and 6 imposing duties upon the Department of Revenue, certain employers, fiduciaries, individuals, persons, corporations 8 and other entities; prescribing crimes, offenses and 9 penalties," in tax for education, further providing for 10 exclusions from the sales and use tax. 11 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: 14 Section 1. Section 204 of the act of March 4, 1971 (P.L.6, 15 No.2), known as the Tax Reform Code of 1971, is amended by 16 adding a clause to read: 17 Section 204. Exclusions from Tax. -- The tax imposed by 18 section 202 shall not be imposed upon any of the following: \* \* \* 19 20 (70) The sale at retail or use of tangible personal property directly and predominantly used to facilitate reading and 21 communicating, including computer and related equipment, by 22

- 1 persons who are blind or visually impaired. For the purpose of
- 2 this clause, the following terms or phrases shall have the
- 3 following meanings:
- 4 (i) "blind" means having a visual acuity of twenty/two
- 5 <u>hundred or less in the better eye with best correction or having</u>
- 6 <u>a limitation of the field of vision such that the widest</u>
- 7 diameter of the visual field subtends an angular distance not
- 8 greater than twenty degrees;
- 9 (ii) "visually impaired" means a prognosis of significantly
- 10 deteriorating vision and either a visual acuity of no better
- 11 than twenty/seventy vision in the better eye with best
- 12 correction or a loss in the field of vision of fifty per cent or
- 13 <u>more.</u>
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
